





MORTGAGE UPDATE

Dear Parishioners,

Our current mortgage rate is at 3.5% for 20 years with a balloon payment due in 2023. This past January, the Federal Reserve (FED) Chairman announced the FED will increase the interest rates at least 6 times this year and no less than 4 times next year to control the rising inflation. At this rate, in 2023 when the balloon payment is due, we could be facing an interest rate of more than 6% which will increase our monthly payment by more than \$1,700 over what we are paying today which is \$10,242.

To prevent this scenario, we were able to work with our current mortgage company to refinance our loan for 15 years, at 3.75% interest rate and balloon payment due in 2029 with NO refinance fees. We started in 2018 with a \$2,000,000 loan and after less than 4 years, we were able to reduce our principal to \$1,350.000. Our new mortgage monthly payment will be \$9,855 which is about \$2,600 less than our original monthly payment.

We could not do this without our benefactors and your generosity and support. Thank you very much, and May God Bless You and St. Sharbel Benediction be with you.

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we observe the Seventh Sunday of Lent with Palm Sunday, we enter into the Holy Week of the final part of the season. We began on Ash Monday, February 28th by hearing the call to fully enter into this season with everything that we've got and to embrace the traditional penances of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. This invitation was repeated throughout the six weeks of Lent. Then, as we realized that we could not do all of this on our own, we were reassured that the Lord would give us all that we need to respond to His call. In this final week of Lent, our attention shifts to the Cross. Many might be surprised to hear that the Cross has not been a focal point in Lent until this week. Up to this point, the Lenten focus has been on our call to change. Now, our Scripture readings and Mass prayers remind us of the great price by which we were redeemed. God delivered his own Son, the innocent Lamb of God, into our hands, as the gift offered for our redemption. God faithfully loved us when we were at our worst.

These final days of Lent lead us into the Triduum, the three-day commemoration of the dying and rising of the Lord. These are the holiest days of the church year. Let us do all that we can to live them well.

During the past two years of the pandemic, the obligation to attend Sunday Mass has been dispensed by our Bishop. Last week, we received word that we are now in a safe position to restore the obligation for us to attend Sunday Mass in person. This begins this Sunday on Palm Sunday. We thank God for safely guiding us through the past two years of the pandemic.

As Lent progresses, let us continue to pray for each other and support each other in our Lenten practices. Many opportunities for the traditional Lenten practices of Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving are listed in the bulletin, as well as times for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

We pray for peace throughout the world, and especially for an end to the violence we have witnessed with the invasion into Ukraine. Wishing you all a blessed Holy Week of Lent, Chorbishop Alfred Badawi, Pastor
