



## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,  
 Jesus Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia! Alleluia! Suffering and death cannot keep our Lord from loving us and drawing us into His love for eternity. The light of Christ has conquered the darkness, and our Lord desires to shine upon us now and forever.

This is the week of Hawareyeen, which means "the angels or the disciples." During this week, we hear the various appearances of the Lord to Peter, Mary Magdalene, to His disciples at the sea of Tiberius, to His disciples on the road to Emmaus, and the appearance in the upper room.

The disciples in the upper room were discouraged because they thought that they would never see the Master again and also because the women said that He was no longer in His tomb. How great is the love of the Lord and His forgiveness. Thomas said: "Unless I see and touch I refuse to believe." Suddenly our Lord appears to them and standing in their midst says: "Peace be with you." They understood immediately that they had broken away from Him and He had not deserted them. Their betrayal had not affected Jesus' relationship with them. If we truly believe in Jesus, shouldn't we live different lives? Are we really any different from these disciples who did not believe?

New Sunday is the new meaning and new way of looking for the Lord. He is no longer revealed in human flesh (as the disciples experienced life with Him); nor in glory (as Thomas experienced). From now on, He is revealed in Spirit, through the experience of faith and the mysteries (sacraments).

Are you still sitting safely in the upper room after having seen the Risen Jesus? Do you have courage to leave your room and announce "Jesus is Risen!" New Sunday is the beginning of a new humanity and world if we believe in Him and become His new witnesses!

## HOLY DAY SERVICES

In addition to our regular weekend Sunday Mass schedule, we celebrated 4 additional "over-flow" Masses and 3 services. Each of the Masses and services were almost filled to capacity. Many of our musicians, choir members, lectors and cantors did double duty returning for multiple Masses and Services on Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and on Easter. Our volunteers slipped in after services on the various days to prepare for the next day. I was in the Church on Holy Saturday morning after the Morning Prayer of Forgiveness. It was incredible to see our various groups descend upon the church and prepare it for the Easter celebrations, each working in their own area of responsibility (Ushers, Greeters, Ladies Altar Society, Safety Committee, and Men's Club). Thank you, again, to all who helped make these experiences so memorable.

I want to say an additional word of thanks to all of you for your flexibility and cooperation with our efforts to welcome our visitors over the past two weekends. We estimated that we served approximately close to 3,500 persons for Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Masses. Like our celebrations in many of our homes, our facilities were stretched to their limits.
