## PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

Jesus Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia! Alleluia! Happy Easter! We celebrate the great feast of our salvation!

Jesus Christ, the truly innocent one, the Lamb of God, has offered His life on our behalf on Good Friday and has conquered sin and death by rising from the dead on Easter Sunday. 
