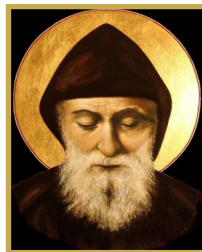

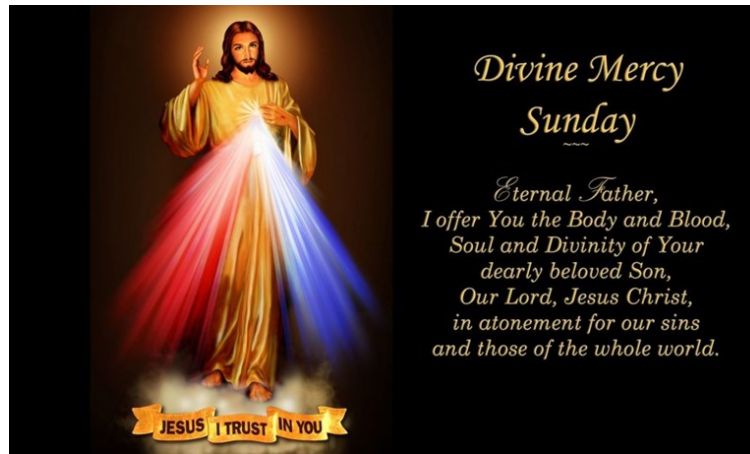

Beginning with the Easter Vigil on Saturday night to full capacity at our Masses on Easter Sunday, it was great to be back together again in person celebrating the Lord's victory over death. As a community, we emerged from the tombs of the COVID virus and stood together in the light of our God. Alleluia!

WITH GRATITUDE

Thank you to all who helped make our observance of Lent and the celebration of the Easter Triduum so prayerful. Thank you to Joe Ejbeh for leading the Lenten Bible Study, and to all who participated during the 6 weeks.
