PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I hope that Lent is going well for you. Today we mark the Sixth Sunday of Lent with the Sunday of the Healing of the Blind Man. Two more weeks and Easter will be here! Soon we will celebrate the feast of the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ, the feast of our salvation, when we are freed from the clutches of sin, suffering, and death and can live in the freedom as sons and daughters of God.

Before we celebrate the glory of the Resurrection, we remember the sacrifice of the Cross and Jesus' Passion.

Next weekend is Palm Sunday, when we greet our Messiah as His disciples greeted Him a week before His crucifixion, with palm branches and shouts of Hosanna. 


