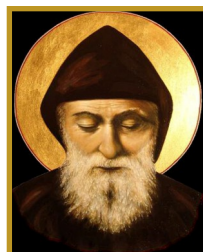

Work on Hayes Road between 18 Mile Road and Hall Road (M-59) in Clinton Township and Sterling Heights is anticipated to start August 15. The road will remain open to thru traffic throughout the duration of the project. Traffic will be restricted to one lane of alternating traffic at times. Some cross street closures may be necessary. Drivers should expect delays and seek alternate routes when possible. Work is anticipated to be completed by mid-November. Estimated dates are subject to change.

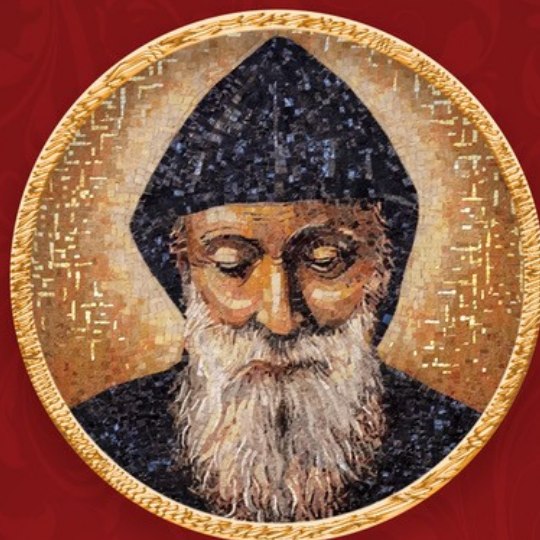

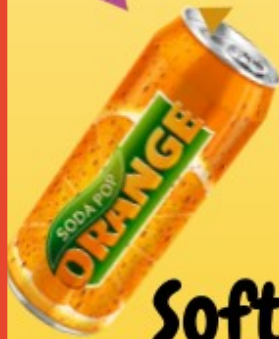
