Dear Friends, Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the summer begins to wind down and Labor Day approaches, we might find ourselves extremely busy or going through the motions, but I would like to recommend using the many great feast days this month to help keep us focused.

The saints are people with whom we can relate. They walked this planet like us and strove for holiness. They received the mercy of God and lived in friendship with Christ, hoping to persevere to that eternal friendship with God in heaven. I would like to give you a glimpse of the many inspiring feast days during the month of August. The month began with the Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major (8/5) and reminds us that Mary is the Mother of God and that with God all things are possible. The Transfiguration (8/6) gives us a glimpse of the glory of the Resurrection that follows the cross. The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (8/15) reminds us of our destination in heaven.
