

Dear Friends,

Your unselfish and charitable hearts are a sign of a living and vibrant Church Community. I have personally witnessed in the eight years of my pastorate of how Christ is the center of your lives. Thank you one and all.

As you know we have been accepting donations to aid the people (our people) of Lebanon. I would love to quote John Steinbeck,
