

The Transfiguration of our Lord take place as Christ is on His way to Jerusalem to fulfill the prophesies of His death on the Cross.

Jesus takes peters, James, and John to a high mountain in order to reveal His glory to them in advance, and to strengthen them in the faith for what is to come – His suffering on the Cross.

The three disciples are frightened while a cloud covers the Lord and from above...they hear the voice of the Father saying: "this is my Son, the beloved, listen to Him."

The Transfiguration of our Lord reveals the glory of Christ and demands that we, His followers, bear witness to this truth.

On this first Sunday of the month of August, our Church calendar celebrates the 9th Sunday of the Pentecost Season. On this first weekend of August, we are now into the final month of the summer please continue to enjoy God's blessings!

Every once in a while a major feast on our regular Church calendar falls on a Sunday in cycle Calendar Year. When that happens, the celebration of the major feast replaces the normal Sunday celebration.

Our regular celebration of the 9th Sunday of the Pentecost Season

is put aside so that we can celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration. We will return to the regular Sunday celebrations next Sunday when we celebrate the 10th Sunday of the Pentecost Season.
