

The Maronite Christmas Novena begins on December 15th and is nine consecutive days of prayer. It is a wonderful way of preparing ourselves for the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ and getting into the Christmas spirit. The Novena will be prayed as a Parish community and includes incensing of the Blessed Sacrament, prayers, Syriac hymns and ends with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.
