





Dear Friends.

A word from Pope Francis ~ "To prepare the way for the Lord who comes, it is necessary to take into account the demands of conversion."

Today we celebrate the Sixth Sunday of the Happy Announcements Season with Genealogy Sunday. We are in the final phase of our preparations.
