

END OF YEAR STATUS

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN END OF THE YEAR 2018 STATUS

Dear St Sharbel Parishioners,

As we get closer to the end of the 2018 calendar year, I would like to take a moment and reflect back to what has a been a great phenomenal year for our Parish.

We completed the construction of our beautiful, humble spiritual home on time and under budget. We secured a \$1.9M loan for 20 years to pay the balance of the construction cost of our project. Bishop Zaidan presided over the Dedication of our Church in a joyful and rich cultural tradition with over one thousand parishioners and supportive friends in attendance. We had a very successful Gala with over 800 people attending and celebrating together the dedication of our new Church. The Gala generated about \$92K to support the Church and our Capital Campaign. We had a very successful Giving Tuesday Campaign that generated \$78,366 to support our Capital Campaign which has exceeded \$3.3M in cash and pledges for the past two years. Our current monthly mortgage payment is \$12,349.71 and our loan balance at the end of 2018 is \$1,878,064.20.

We could not have achieved all these accomplishments without the leadership of Chorbishop Badawi and the countless number of volunteers who have put tremendous effort and time in to support all these events. However, we all know our journey is not over; our future will depend on the planning and the actions we plan and execute today.

We have vibrant and energetic youth groups that we should empower and encourage to take responsibilities in our future planning. We have to envision what we want our Parish to look like - spiritually, culturally, socially, and financially - 10 to 15 years into the future. This will require participation, responsibility and accountability by all of us regardless of age and gender.

You heard me say it once, "If you want to go fast, go alone; if you want to go farther, go together". If we believe it, we can achieve it. I am very proud to be a member of the St Sharbel family that is defined by not only the love and adoration we have to our Lord and our Patron Saint, but also by the respect, care, kindness, generosity, sacrifices, compassion, forgiveness, and unselfishness we have toward each other. I have great faith in our community and I look forward to a greater and more successful 2019 year.

Finally, I would like to wish everyone of you a very Merry Christmas and a Happy, Safe, Joyful, Successful, and Prosperous New Year.
