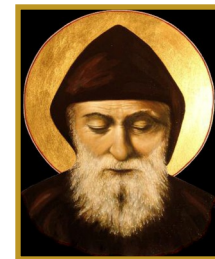

LITURGICALLY SPEAKING

SUNDAY OF THE RIGHTEOUS AND THE JUST

This Sunday the Maronite Church celebrates the Sunday of the Righteous and Just. This is actually the traditional Maronite feast in honor of all the saints. Whereas the Latin Church celebrates the feast of All Saints on November 1st, the Maronite Church, following its ancient tradition, dedicates this Sunday to their memory.

On this day we call to mind all the men, women, and children of the Church who have followed the path of justice and righteousness. We remember the prophets, apostles and martyrs, the hermits, ascetics, men and women religious, as well as all Christians who have led holy lives. As our Liturgy so often reminds us, they are just in the sight of God because they have patterned their lives on Jesus Christ, the Just One.

The saints are our models; their prayers and fasting have taught us to fight against sin and temptation and so gain the reward of righteousness. The saints are our intercessors; by their prayers we obtain the pardon of our sins and are strengthened in the Christian virtues. They were the salt of the earth and the light of the world, and they call us to follow their path. Through their intercession may we, one day, merit eternal life with God.

All you holy saints in heaven, pray for us! Amen.

LENTEN OBSERVANCES 2022

For us Maronites, Lent begins on Ash Monday, February 28, 2022 and lasts until Holy Saturday (April 16) at noon. The following Lenten guidelines are observed in the Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon. All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (February 28) and all Fridays of Lent.

Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

ASH MONDAY

The Liturgy for Ash Monday [February 28] will be at 9 AM, 12 PM and 7 PM.

Blessing of Ashes will take place at the Liturgy. Ash Monday is a day of complete fast and abstinence.

Our Friday Lenten Devotion will begin on Friday, March 4, 2022 and continue every Friday of Lent. The Divine Liturgy followed by the Benediction of the Holy Cross will take place at 7 PM.
