





PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Our Maronite Church celebrates on the first Sunday of Lent Cana Sunday. Jesus comes to the wedding and brings with Him His Mother, disciples and His divine friendship.

The Wedding at Cana was perfect, not because of the friends or of the waiters, but because of the presence and help of Mary that day when the Spirit spoke through her. She asked Jesus to help when she said, "They have no wine." She trusted her Son, and she knew that whatever she asked of Him she would receive, because He would never refuse His Mother's request.

CANA SUNDAY

As we enter the Great Fast, Cana Sunday reminds us of these deep truths. Catholic Marriage is meant to establish Christian foyers that radiate faith and virtue. Christian catechesis and teaching within the family – lived each day – creates another generation in the apostolic chain, link by link, stretching from the morning of the Resurrection all the way to the Parousia. Through Sacred Crowning, most of us will live within this sacred zone as we all await the full manifestation of Our Lord and Savior on the Last Day. Let us prepare ourselves for Lent, for that final wedding feast between God and humanity. We are waiting for that hour to come. It is a sign of hope from Him which will be repeated during the Last Supper when He changes the wine into blood and the bread into His body.

LENT 2021

Lent begins this **Monday**, **February 15th with Ash Monday**. The Liturgy will be celebrated with the Blessing and Distribution of Ashes at 9:00 AM, 12:00 PM and 7:00 PM.

Every Friday during Lent, beginning February 19th through Friday, March 26th, we will pray the Stations and Benediction of the Cross at 7:00 PM in the Church. Friday, April 2nd is Friday of the Passion of the Lord.

LENTEN OBSERVANCES

All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (February15, 2021) and all Fridays of Lent.

Ash Monday and Good Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon.

THE YEAR OF SAINT JOSEPH

On the 150th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church, Pope Francis wrote,

"WITH A FATHER'S HEART: that is how Joseph loved Jesus, whom all four Gospels refer to as *"the son of Joseph."*

Let us pray the prayer Pope Francis has prayed for over 40 years:

"Glorious Patriarch Saint Joseph, whose power makes the impossible possible, come to my aid in these times of anguish and difficulty. Take under your protection the serious and troubling situations that I commend to you, that they may have a happy outcome. My beloved father, all my trust is in you. Let it not be said that I invoked you in vain, and since you can do everything with Jesus and Mary, show me that your goodness is as great as your power. Amen."
