



#### PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In only 2 weeks, we will begin the sacred season of Lent. Ash Monday is on February 24th this year, and Easter Sunday will be April 12<sup>th</sup>.

Lent is a penitential time to prepare ourselves to celebrate the feast of our salvation, when Christ freed us from sin and death. On Easter, when Christ conquered the tomb by rising from the dead, we will renew our baptismal promises, remembering what St. Paul said:

"Or are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life" (Rom. 6:34; cf. Col. 2:12).

It is easy to fall into old habits or to let our faith be something routine.

As we approach Lent, it is important to start thinking about our Lenten practices. The three Lenten disciplines are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. I encourage you to do one of each: to give something up, to love God in prayer, and to love one's neighbor through charity.

I also encourage you to make the time to join us for the Parish Lenten Reflections with the Stations of the Cross on the Fridays of Lent, as well as at the Friday Lenten Dinner.

It is of the utmost importance that we go to confession during Lent. Please remember that Fridays during Lent are days to abstain from meat for anyone over the age of fourteen, and that Ash Monday and Good Friday are days to abstain from meat and fast for anyone between the ages of eighteen and fifty-nine.

There will be a Mass and Procession in honor of Saint Sharbel on Saturday, February 22, 2020 at 6:30PM. All are invited to attend and pray for their special intentions. The Mass intention will be offered for the Sick and all the Pregnant Mothers in our communities.

We will be collecting old palms through February 23rd. A basket will be placed in the Narthex for them. We will be burning these blessed palms and the ashes will then be used for Ash Monday Services on February 24th.

The Stations of the Cross are a popular devotion among Catholics. Through prayer, we reflect in following Jesus Christ on His way to Calvary and we honor the passion of Jesus. St. Sharbel offers Stations of the Cross each Friday of Lent in the evening at 7PM.
