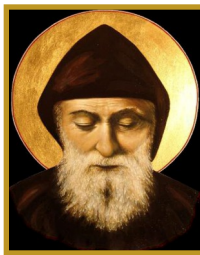

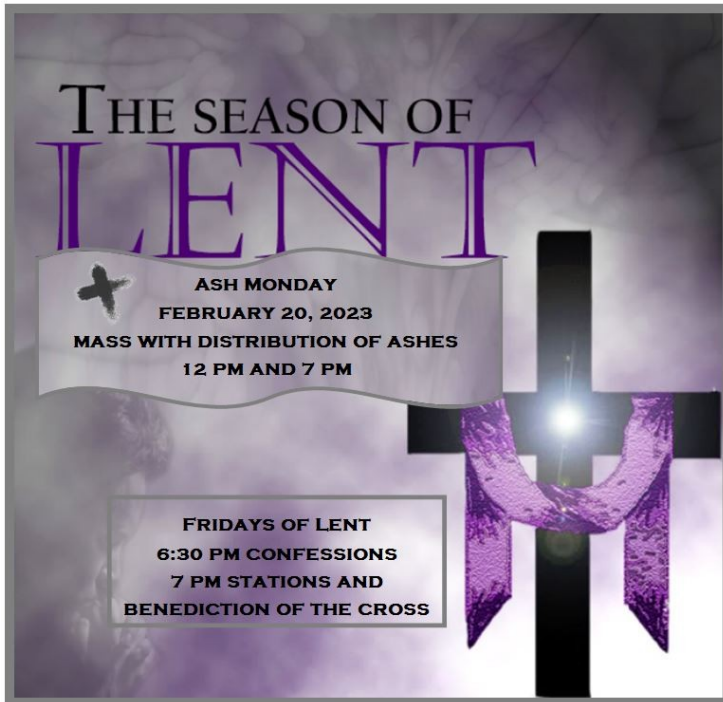

## REFLECTION FOR LENT

**Reflection on Cana Sunday: Entrance into the Season of Great Lent****By: Deacon Chris Nahra**

I can't believe we have already made it to Lent –time is just flying by. If you're like me then you probably have even thought about what you are going to give up for Lent this year. Every year, I say I'm going to give up chocolate or television or (dare I even say) coffee, however, each year Lent concludes, and I think to myself... so what did I accomplish or how did I change? Well, perhaps this year, the Season of Great Lent can be different for both you and me. Perhaps, this year, instead of striving to just endure our fasts, sacrifices, and extra prayers for 40 days, we thrive in our journey with God and ourselves where we encounter the true living God, Jesus Christ, who wishes to have a deep relationship with each and every one of us – no matter where we are in life.

Catherine Doherty, a Russian-Canadian Catholic social worker and founder of the Madonna House Apostolate, once said: "Lent is a time of going very deeply into ourselves... What is it that stands between us and God? Between us and our brothers and sisters? Between us and life, the life of the Spirit? Whatever it is, let us relentlessly tear it out, without a moment's hesitation." You see, brothers and sisters, Lent is a time of conversion, a time to journey with our Lord and with ourselves. This sacred season of Great Lent gives each of us in the Church an opportunity to look deep within themselves and discover where we need to grow. Many of us (including myself) sometimes treat Lent as a test of endurance thinking to ourselves: "how long can I go with giving up coffee." Then, when we break our fast, we become discouraged and try to restart again or simply give up. But there is SO much more to Lent than just endurance.

Lent is a daily journey rooted in our relationship with God and with others which does include our fasting, prayers, almsgiving, and sacrifices. During this season of Great Lent, we have the opportunity to spiritually join ourselves to all our Christian Catholic brothers and sisters across the world who are also journeying in Lent. Through our daily prayers, Scripture readings, and sacrifices, we begin to grow closer to Christ personally and as a whole Church. Lent is also a time when families can grow closer together. It's the small things that will make a difference such as gathering to pray before a meal or going to Sunday Divine Liturgy as a family. As a family, you could go on a pilgrimage to a Catholic Shrine and look for service opportunities in your local parish and/or community. Lent is a time of spiritual reflection. Many individuals go on a weekend retreat or a one-day retreat to get away from the noisy world and calm their thoughts and minds in solitude with God. Lastly, Lent is also a time for fasting. However, I invite you not to just fast for the sake of fasting. Fast from things that draw you away from God and your vocation in life. For example, if you watch too much TV and it strips you away from your work and/or family, then give up TV (Netflix, TikTok, etc). Ultimately, we know ourselves best, and so this Lent is an opportunity to really discover what takes us away from God and from our mission in life.

In conclusion, brothers and sisters, rejoice and be glad because the season of Great Lent is upon us which means, today, is the day to begin our journey with God and with ourselves. Do not be afraid to look deep within yourself and discover where you need to grow this Lent. It's not about endurance, it's about a journey. Walk with Christ each day and you will conclude Lent on Resurrection Sunday as a new person. Draw closer to your family and friends during Lent through prayer and service. Fast from things that genuinely take you away from God and take some time to retreat from the busy and noisy world around us. Finally, remember that this season of Great Lent is about our relationship with God, the God who deeply desires to draw closer to each and every one of us. However, we must open wide the doors of our hearts to let Christ in. Never forget that Great Lent is truly a gift that "makes justice abound and holiness thrive" (Maronite Qurbono, 186)

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

Dear Friends in Christ,

Cana Sunday greetings to all! This Sunday we celebrate the Wedding at Cana, the traditional entrance into Great Lent, and the time that we take for the Renewal of Marriage Vows.

**ASH MONDAY**

Tomorrow is Ash Monday [February 20] when we will gather for Liturgies and the distribution of ashes. The Liturgy for Ash Monday [February 20] will be at 12 PM and 7 PM. The Blessing of Ashes will take place during each Liturgy.

**LENTEN MEAL - BRING A DISH TO PASS**

Following the 7:00 PM Liturgy on Ash Monday, a simple Lenten meal will be served in the parish hall. Please bring a dish to share with your fellow parishioners.

**LENTEN FASTING GUIDELINES**

Ash Monday is a day of complete fast and abstinence. The following Lenten guidelines are observed in the Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon.

- All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (February 20) and all Fridays of Lent.
- Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat.
- All Maronites who are physically capable are too fast on these two days.

**FRIDAYS OF LENT**

On the first Friday of Lent [February 24] and ALL Fridays of Great Lent, members of the Clergy will be present to give a special Lenten "Mission" Reflection to our parishioners and friends.

Our Lenten Services will begin on Friday, February 24, 2023, and every Friday of Lent thereafter. Confessions will be heard at 6:30 PM and the Stations and Benediction of the Holy Cross at 7:00 PM.

**LENT BIBLE STUDY**

Our Lent bible Study will begin on Wednesday, March 1st and will be held for 6 weeks. Joe Ejbeh will be the facilitator.

**TRAGEDY AT MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY**

Let us keep in our prayers all those affected by this week's tragic occurrence on the Campus of Michigan State University. The effects are wide spread and have touched our own community, as many of our young people are currently enrolled as students; we have many alumni as well. We pray for peace, comfort and consolation for all, as well as healing for those students critically injured.

May our Lord have mercy on all and hear our prayers. Saint Sharbel, pray for all the victims. Amen.
