



LENTEN OBSERVANCES

LENTEN OBSERVANCES 2022

For us Maronites, Lent begins on Ash Monday, February 28, 2022 and lasts until Holy Saturday (April 16) at noon. The following Lenten guidelines are observed in the Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon. All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (February 28) and all Fridays of Lent.

Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

ASH MONDAY

The Liturgy for Ash Monday February 28, 2022 will be at 9 AM, 12 PM and 7 PM.

Blessing of Ashes will take place at each Liturgy. *Ash Monday is a day of complete fast and abstinence.

FRIDAY LENTEN DEVOTION

Our Friday Lenten Devotion will begin on Friday, March 4, 2022 and continue every Friday of Lent. The Divine Liturgy will be celebrated at 7 PM followed by the Benediction of the Holy Cross.

LITURGICALLY SPEAKING

SUNDAY OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

Today the Maronite Church commemorates all the faithful Christians who have departed this life in the faith. This feast is the Syriac Church's equivalent to the feast of All Souls in the Latin Church. We ask our Lord Jesus Christ to welcome all our deceased brothers and sisters, who have been nourished with his body and blood, into his kingdom of light. Not knowing the state of perfection they have achieved in their lives, we commend them to the mercy of God with hope and expectation.

It is a Christian obligation for us to help our brothers and sisters through our prayers and the offering of the Divine Mysteries for their salvation. For though they have not yet reached the joy of the righteous and the just, they are called to ultimately enter the kingdom of light and peace. Our intercession can bring them nearer to the day of eternal happiness. We should pray in a special way for those who have been near us, our relatives, friends and benefactors who have died. At the same time we should pray for the deceased members of our parish and for all the departed who have no one to pray for them. We commend the faithful departed to the Lord that by His cross He may lead them into the eternal wedding feast, and as newly arrived in God's kingdom may they intercede before Him on our behalf. PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Now I don't want to surprise anyone, but Lent is just 7 days away - next Sunday midnight! While it might not be the most fun season of the Church year, these forty days in the desert with our Lord should be an annual time to return to the basics of our faith. And one of the best ways to ensure that you have a successful Lent is to take time to prepare for the season.

With Ash Monday coming quickly, I want to recommend that you start praying about what penances the Lord wants you to take on for these 40 days. It is good to remember the three traditional disciplines of Lent:

Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving.

Here are just a few suggestions to consider as you prepare for this season. Remember that nature hates a vacuum, so if you give something up, be sure you have a plan of what to fill that time with! And Lent isn't a competition about the most intense penance, but really asking what will help you grow with the Lord.

> Come to daily Mass each morning Recitation of the Rosary Make a good confession No alcohol No snacks between meals No Netflix, etc. No cable news No videogames No social media A clothing purge...donating anything not regularly used to St. Vincent DePaul or the Salvation Army. No phone use before your prayers in the morning or after your prayers at night. No cream or sugar in your coffee No meat for all of Lent
