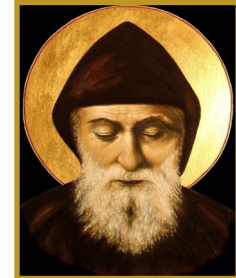



LENT 2021

Lent this year will start on Monday, February 15th with Ash Monday. The Liturgy will be celebrated with Blessing and Distribution of Ashes at 9:00 AM, 12:00 PM and 7:00 PM.

Every Friday during Lent, beginning February 19th through Friday, March 26th, we will pray the Stations and Benediction of the Cross at 7:00 PM in the Church. Friday, April 2nd is Friday of the Passion of the Lord.

LENTEN OBSERVANCES

All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (February 15, 2021) and all Fridays of Lent.

Ash Monday and Good Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon.

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Sunday of the Faithful Departed

Today the Maronite Church commemorates all the faithful Christians who have departed this life in the faith. This feast in the Syriac Churches is equivalent to the feast of All Souls in the Latin Church. We ask our Lord Jesus Christ to welcome all the deceased brothers and sisters, who have been nourished with His Body and Blood, into His kingdom of light. Not knowing the state of perfection they have achieved in their lives, we commend them to the mercy of God with hope and expectation. It is a Christian obligation for us to help our brothers and sisters through our prayers and the offering of Divine Mysteries for their salvation. For though they have not yet reached the joy of the righteous and the just, they are called to ultimately enter the kingdom of light and peace. Our intercession can bring them nearer to the day of eternal happiness. We should pray in a special way for those who have been near us, our relatives, friends and benefactors who have died. At the same time for the deceased members of our parish and for all the departed who have no one to pray for them. We commend the faithful departed to the Lord that by His Cross He may lead them into the eternal wedding feast, and newly arrived in God's kingdom may they intercede before Him on our behalf.

FEAST OF SAINT MARON

Tuesday, February 9th is the Feast of Saint Maron, a Holy Day of Obligation for all Maronites, who must attend Mass on the Feast under pain of mortal sin. For the convenience of the parishioners, the Feast Day Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 PM.

All that is known about Maron, the spiritual father and protector of the Maronites, comes from Theodoret, the Bishop of Cyr. He never knew Maron personally, but only through the disciples of this holy man. He described Maron as "the one who has planted for God the garden which flourishes now in the region of Cyr." He felt that Maron was a man born not for this world, but for heaven.

Maron was the spiritual leader not only of the hermits who lived near him, but indeed of all the Christian faithful in the area. He used to counsel them, heal their bodily and spiritual ills.

The date of Maron's death is placed around the year 410. Because of his great popularity among the people, riots broke out at the time of his death because everyone wanted to save his remains in their village. The Maronite Church formerly celebrated the feast of this great saint on January 5th. (This is the day in which the Church of Kfarhai, Lebanon, was consecrated in his honor.) However, in the 7th century, the feast was transferred to February 9th.

Lebanon has proclaimed Maron as its patron saint, and Pope Benedict XIV granted a plenary indulgence to everyone who visited a Maronite Church on February 9th.

The gospel tells us that a tree is known by its fruits and we know from Theodoret that the garden of Maron flourished after his death. One is able to number approximately 20 saints among Maron's disciples.

After the Council of Chalcedon, Bishop Theodoret worked to construct the famous Monastery of Saint Maron. In addition to being a stronghold for the defense of the teachings of the Council of Chalcedon, this monastery was for a long time the center of the cultural and theological heritage of Antioch.
