



Dear Parishioners of St Sharbel- Michigan

Thank you to Reverend Cor bishop Alfred Badawi for welcoming our Eparchial Religious Education Board and hosting the workshop.

Since my journey began as a nun, I have always been serving my mission in the Religious Education sector among schools and parishes. I moved from Australia to Los Angeles to continue in this journey.

We are blessed to have our Bishop Elias Zaidan who prioritizes Religious Education. He has formed a committee dedicated to improve on the methods of teaching the faith. He sees the need to keep the children engaged and interested so they stay rooted in the Maronite faith.

The role of the Church, clergy and the catechists, is to share the faith with you. Therefore, the Bishop has sent us to gather catechists from the different neighboring Maronite Parishes and provide them with the training on the new methods of teaching to reach our upcoming digital generation. However, this mission cannot be successful if this is not a shared responsibility with YOU, the parents. REMEMBER one hand cannot clap alone! You and your extended family have to first bring your children to church. You are your children's first church and play an important role in their lives. It's time for you to determine what your priorities are: your children's sports and other activities, or their relationship with God? If their relationship with God is important to you, you have to start at a young age and be consistent. Attending weekly mass and religious Education, has to be part of your weekend routine. It's really up to you...

If your priorities are elsewhere, don't be surprised if your children's priorities end up elsewhere. Then the next generation will not be active in our Maronite churches, and eventually, our Maronite churches will end up with empty pews and their doors will close. It's up to you to hold on to our Maronite faith and traditions so it does not dissolve.

In addition, we need new vocations from the young generation, the young generation meaning your children, to carry on our faith and traditions. I came from Lebanon and have served there in the schools: believe me when I tell you the mentality in the east is different from the mentality in the west. We need vocations here from the west to serve in our churches here in the United States.

If we all have the same concern, we need to cooperate so we ensure our faith survives the test of time. For our churches to stay enlightened, we need to work together so we can build the kingdom of God!




