

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This week St. Sharbel Maronite Catholic Church will host for the first time in our new church the relics of Saint Sharbel Makhlouf. The relics will be available for veneration this week Tuesday, January 22, Friday, Saturday and Sunday, January 25, 26 and 27. The Saint is known worldwide as a miracle Saint for his spiritual and physical healings.

The four days of the visit will be marked with Liturgies, Prayer, Confession and Veneration of this most Holy Saint of the Church. St. Sharbel Parish is looking forward to hosting visitors while the relics are in Clinton Township. Deacon Mike said. "We aspire and hope that many other people from the local area will come, especially the Chaldean community that has a devotion to St. Sharbel."

Saint Sharbel, a humble Lebanese monk from the 19th century, has been credited with thousands of miracles since his death in 1898. We receive notification of many local people who have reported miraculous answers to prayers through the intercession of Saint Sharbel.

Saint Sharbel was born Youssef Makhlouf in Lebanon and became a monk, taking the name of the martyr, Charbel. The last 23 years of his life were lived in total silence and austere penance in a hermitage where he slept on the hard ground. He died on Christmas Eve of 1898. Pope Paul VI beatified him in 1965 and canonized him a saint 12 years later.

I'd like to thank His Excellency Gaby Issa, Ambassador of Lebanon to the United States, the Consul General of Lebanon in Detroit Mrs. Souzan Mouzi, dignitaries, parishioners, guests, friends, committee members, choir members, ushers, altar servers, the Knights of Columbus, and the members of the Order of Saint Sharbel for their attendance. Also, thank you to Antonio's Market and La Saj Bistro for their outstanding generosity.

Lastly, but not least, I'd like to thank all of the volunteers who have spent many, many hours preparing for this week to make it the most hospitable for all of our guests and visitors, and to Valerie Menassa and Dianne for overseeing this endeavor!




