





Glory to God!

On January 19, 2024 at 9:30 AM a mosaic depicting the image of St. Charbel Makhlouf will be solemnly placed in the Vatican Grottoes located in the basement of St. Peter's Basilica. His Eminence Card. Mauro Gambetti, Archpriest of St. Peter's Papal Basilica, will preside over the Rite of Blessing.

At 10:00 AM, also in the Vatican Grottoes but precisely in the Hungarian Chapel, His Excellency Archbishop Rafic Warcha, Procurator of the Maronite Patriarch to the Holy See and Rector of the Pontifical Maronite College, will preside at the Mass of Thanksgiving.

Due to the nature of the venue, the event is not open to the public. Instead, we are all called to participate with prayer and to share in the joy of the event.

Cardinal Rahi is asking the Bishops of Lebanon to ring a bell for 5 minutes during the unveiling of the mosaic in honor of the solemnity of this monumental event. We are all asked to observe a period of prayer in thanksgiving this Friday.

The annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity began this past Thursday, January 18, and concludes this coming Thursday, January 25 on the feast of the Conversion of St. Paul the Apostle.
