Bishop Simon Faddoul is its first Eparchial Bishop.

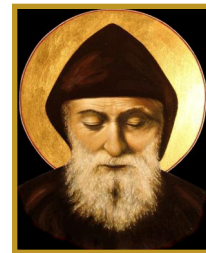

MARONITE EPARCHY OF AFRICA

The Maronite Catholic Eparchy of the Annunciation
 On the 28th of February 2018, the Holy Father, following the votes of the bishops of the Patriarchal Church of Antioch for the Maronites has elevated the Apostolic Exarchate to the Eparchy of the Annunciation with a see in Ibadan, Nigeria, and appointed Rev. Chorbishop Simon Faddoul as its first Eparchial Bishop.

Maronite Presence in Africa
 The migration of the Lebanese in general and the Maronites specifically to Africa started as early as the 1870s as a result of the extremely difficult situation our people went through, especially in the aftermath of the massacres that were committed against the Christians of Lebanon and Syria between 1840 and 1860 where hundreds of villages, churches, and monasteries were burned, and thousands of people massacred. Soon after, came the migration of the grand famine during and after World War I, followed by another wave of migrants in the 1930s and 1940s; then came the last collective migration during the years of Lebanon’s civil war between 1975 and 1990 (Ref. Dr. Joseph Labaki, The Maronite Expansion in the World). Since the 1990s, migration to Africa has been rather limited to professional young men and women who are temporarily employed by either Lebanese owned or by global companies.

Parishes
 The Maronite Eparchy of the Annunciation has 12 parishes in 8 countries of Central and West Africa, namely: Nigeria, Benin, Togo, Ghana, Burkina Faso, Côte d’Ivoire, Senegal, and Liberia. It has 8 missions, 4 in Nigeria and 3 in other countries: Niger, Mali, Sierra Leone, and Burkina Faso that could become parishes in the future should all parish components become present. In addition to that numerous communities in West and Central Africa have expressed their desire to study the possibility of establishing new missions.
