



The annual Hair Cutting Ceremony for children born in 2022 from our Parish Community will take place at all the Masses this weekend. Bring your CHILD and join us!

LITURGICALLY SPEAKING

MEANING OF THE HAIRCUTTING CEREMONY

During the ordination of a Subdeacon, the Bishop cuts a small piece of hair off the candidate's head in the form of a cross symbolizing his old life being left behind and the beginning of a new life.

This is called the "tonsure" which means in *Latin* to clip off or shear. Tonsure indicates something new occurring where an individual is called to be a witness of the faith in his or her actions and words.

This beautiful ritual shows us that we are called to be different as baptized Maronite Catholics in the world. We are given new life in Christ Jesus and called to live it out in our Christian communities.

And so, "tonsure" is a sign of our Christian identify rooted in the Risen Lord Jesus who gives us purpose, meaning, and a mission to spread the Good News of the Gospel each day of our lives.


