



ST. SHARBEL HALL

Dear Friends,

For the past 7 weeks we have been celebrating our Divine Liturgy in our new and beautiful sanctuary while the rest of our complex: church hall, kitchen, classrooms, offices, conference rooms, furniture, and inside and outside finishing touches are getting done. We are projecting by mid-July that all the minor issues and the rest of the furniture will be done and delivered.

As you noticed our hall is very beautiful and equipped with very nice furniture, kitchen appliances and equipment. I know there have been several inquiries from people who own restaurants or catering services expressing a desire and interest to operate the hall through on demand or regular catering services. I believe we have a great opportunity to improve our positive cash flow through proper usage and operation of our hall. The revenue generated from the hall operation will be used to support our monthly mortgage payment and day to day operations.

Chorbishop Badawi has made it very clear that the final decision of the hall operation is strictly a business decision. Based on our estimate, the completed hall has cost us around \$1.5M and it would be a very poor business decision if we end up treating it and using it as a cost and budget liability rather than a profit venue.

In order to have a fair and balanced decision regarding the operation of the hall, we will be accepting proposals from professionals who are interested. All proposals must be submitted to the Church Office in a sealed envelope, clearly marked, no later than July 31, 2018. These must be in the format of a written proposal detailing the suggested operation.

A Hall Operation Committee will be formed to review all submitted proposals. Follow-up in person meetings will be scheduled as needed. The final decision will be strictly based on the best business operation proposal that would provide the maximum profit to our budget while maintaining the integrity and sanctity of the site.

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

With the warm weather upon us, it's a good time to think about proper attire to be worn in Church. There is no doubt that both kids and adults want to be comfortable. The issue at hand though is respect. Some of our parish members are fortunate to have a membership to various golf courses. They have a dress code of no jeans allowed and a collared shirt must be worn. While it might be more comfortable to wear a pair of jean shorts and a t-shirt to play golf, a certain amount of decorum is required which is respected by all its members. The same holds true to those attending a high school dance. Proper attire is required.

A teenage girl would not dream of attending the prom in shorts, flip flops and t-shirt, and nor would her date. So why should parents and the parish community settle for shorts, t-shirts and flip flops when we have much more present here? We have the King of the Universe, the Creator of the world present in the Holy Eucharist in our presence. So what would Jesus say about the proper attire? We have only to look at Scripture.

Jesus himself had a seamless tunic that was of such value, the Roman soldiers threw dice on Calvary for it. Because it was seamless, it was of great value. He also told the story about the man who was thrown out of a banquet because he didn't have the proper dress. While the parable is talking about our spiritual preparedness, the example is of being properly attired at a banquet, which all who heard, understood the illustration. The proper attire is really rather simple. For both men and women, shorts and bare shoulders are discouraged, as they are viewed as irreverent before the Eucharist (the norm in Europe is admittance is not allowed into Churches if wearing shorts or baring shoulders). Additionally, women should not wear miniskirts or clothing that bares midriffs or tops that are low cut. Modesty is a simple guideline for both men and women. We all want to grow in love of God. One very simple way is in the way we present ourselves to Him when we receive Holy Communion. It's all about respect. Is there anyone we should respect or honor more?

This coming Wednesday, we celebrate Independence Day. We reflect upon this great gift of freedom God has bestowed upon our country. We take time to say, "Thank you, Lord, for allowing us to be free!" May we always cherish this gift and never take it for granted.

The sacrifice of Jesus has set us free from the bonds of death and sin. St. Paul tells us that "no distinction is made: all have sinned and lack God's glory, and all are justified by the free gift of God's grace through being set free in Christ Jesus." (Romans 3:23-24) May we use our freedom to do more than avoid sin. May we make Jesus' reign here on earth one of peace and love, always lived out in freedom.

Finally, please don't forget your contribution to St. Sharbel Parish when you are on vacation. You can either drop your envelope in the basket before you leave on vacation, or when you return. We count on your generosity all year long. Thank you!
