



LITURGICALLY SPEAKING

Placing our faith and trust in God, whom we cannot see, is not always easy. We wonder why suffering exists and question the meaning of life and our purpose in the world. We wonder if God is really present during the most challenging of life circumstances.

Sometimes we experience spiritual dryness, in which God seems distant or absent.

At times, we may feel strong in faith, until a situation at home or work requires us to act as a person of faith, and suddenly faith is no longer easy, convenient, or comfortable.

These moments are so common that we speak of taking a "leap of faith," when we act out of faith, even when the result of doing so is uncertain.

Such a leap is often a turning point in our lives, as we find strength, healing and peace in turning our burdens and anxieties over to God in trust. Saint Augustine said,

"Faith is to believe what you do not see. The result of this faith is to see what you believe."

> "Faith isn't a feeling. It's a choice to trust God even when the road ahead seems uncertain."

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

As we celebrate the 9th Sunday of the Pentecost Season this weekend, we reach the mid-point of the summer.

The formal dedication of our beautiful new church is just two months away on September 16th at 11:00 am. Why this formality? Why not just start using the main altar once we have the occupancy permit?

Because the Sanctuary is a unique space set aside for an extraordinary purpose, a place for the repose of the living God.

Not only the building itself but the interior furnishings must be consecrated, especially those such as the altar and tabernacle most intimately associated with the Sacramental Mystery of the Real Presence. The beautiful Rite for the Dedication of a Church is one of the gems of our Catholic tradition and one you won't want to miss. The ceremony begins at 11:00 am with an address (Office of Liturgy). Then the Bishop, priests and congregation process over to the new church singing Psalm 122, "Let us go Rejoicing." This psalm is one of the 'songs of ascent', sung by the people of Israel on pilgrimages to the temple in Jerusalem. The temple and Jerusalem are at a higher elevation, so the approach always involved ascending, both literally and spiritually. Psalm 122 is the third such psalm, sung upon arrival in Jerusalem approaching the temple mount, so is particularly appropriate for our procession.

The procession arrives outside the closed church doors where the keys and legal ownership documents are formally passed by the Bishop, the principal celebrant. The Bishop calls for the doors to be opened and leads the congregation inside a darkened, bare sanctuary.

After the Bishop's homily in a beautiful and ancient tradition, the furnishings are anointed, incensed, and consecrated to their sacred purpose as part of the Dedication Mass.

So mark your calendars and stay tuned for more dedication weekend previews in subsequent bulletins.

Finally, please don't forget your contribution to St. Sharbel Church when you are on vacation. You can either drop your envelope in the basket before you leave on vacation, or when you return. We count on your generosity all year long. Thank you!


