

MYO NATIONAL RETREAT

The theme to this year's MYO National Retreat was "Who I Am". It centered around four statements that are in the Scriptures: Chosen, Forgiven, Transformed and God's Masterpiece.

The first day taught us how we are all Chosen by God to experience and learn of His love for us and how He wants us to share in Eternal Life with Him in Heaven.

The second day we learned that we are Forgiven. We learn of God's mercy and love for us despite our shortcomings. We should repent of our sins, like the disobedient son in the parable of the Prodigal Son. God wants to restore us back to a favored status before our sins were committed and He is waiting for us with open arms to show us mercy and that we belong with Him. All we have to do is go to Confession.

On the third day, we learned about being Transformed. Since we are chosen and forgiven, when we fall short and repent, we become Transformed in who we are as Maronite Catholics and children of God. We learned that all our truest desires lead us to Him. There is nothing in this world that can satisfy these desires. Worldly desires give us temporary satisfaction. These desires tend to lead us away from God never being satisfied. Transformation causes us to realize how much God loves each one of us and wants us to spend eternity with Him. We are His one true child. That is why we try to live virtuously and serve one another in love.

On the final day, we learned how we are all God's Masterpiece. Each one of us is unique in our own way and have been Blessed with talents that we can use in serving one another to glorify God. All of us advisors became transformed in showing our love and devotion to our kids who are the future disciples that are so important in last week's Gospel Reading to heal the sick and infirmed. I witnessed so many parents show love and devotion to so many of the youth, helping them to know they are loved and important to God. The parent advisors also kept all the parents not at the retreat informed of how their kids were doing.

This retreat brought out what a true Church is: a parish community that loves and serves one another in following the teachings of Christ. We should all praise God for Fr. Edward, the leader of the MYO National Board, and all Board members who worked so hard to transform each one of us with the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. They are modern day disciples, like the disciples Jesus sent out in last week's Gospel. Now one can understand why it is important to build a Church Community that grows and serves one another in bringing Christ to its members. This board did just that - engaging all the parent advisors to help our youth learn they are a child to the One True King: our Loving, Merciful God.




