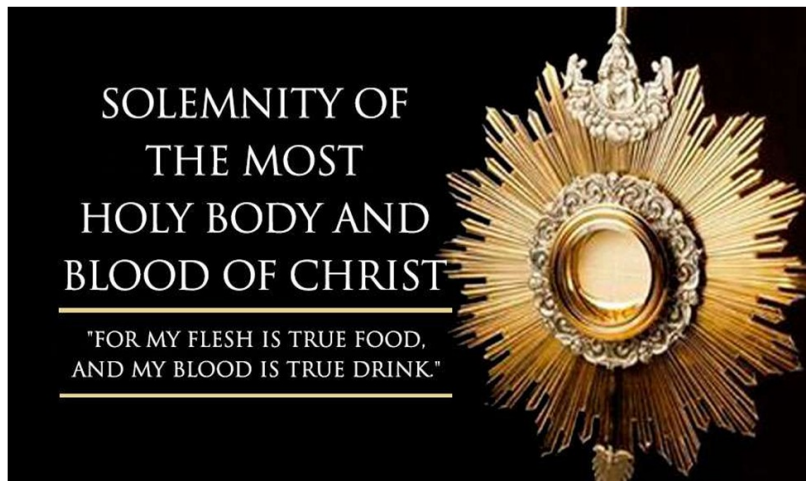

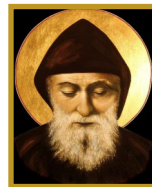

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,  
 Last weekend we had approximately 200 people, combined, at the Liturgies. I pray that some of you will take advantage of having an extra Liturgy on Saturday and Sunday at 6:00 PM. We will keep these Liturgies for the month of June for now.

During the month of June we celebrate many commemorations and saints days. The feast of Saint Anthony of Padua, a popular saint in the church for instance, is June 13<sup>th</sup>. It happens to fall on Saturday. This same weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi Sunday. Even though this is a feast associated more with the Western Tradition, Maronite Catholics have observed it for many years.

After all Masses this weekend we are having a Eucharistic procession, processing inside of the Church with the Blessed Sacrament (the Eucharist). Not only does the procession give honor to our Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament, but the procession also symbolizes that we walk together in Christ, bringing Him into our world to transform it, heal it, and raise it up. The act of procession reminds us that we bring Christ out of our churches and into our world. We are on a journey together to our heavenly homeland. Like the Israelites who wandered in the desert to the Promised Land, fed only by manna, which was like bread that had fallen from Heaven, we journey toward the Promised Land of Heaven, fed by the true bread that has come down from Heaven to give us life: Jesus Christ. We give God thanks for the gift of the Holy Eucharist: the sacrament of the love of Christ.

On Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>, we will have a special outdoor Mass in honor of Saint Sharbel. We need to reinstate the monthly devotions to Saint Sharbel. Again, if you are more comfortable by attending in your cars please do so. Even though we will be outside, masks will be required. I ask that you bring your own lawn or folding chairs from your home.

We will conclude with the Chaplet of Saint Sharbel and benediction with his relics. Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 PM by Fr. Sameem Balius, Pastor of Sacred Heart Chaldean Catholic Church in Warren, MI. If the weather is inclement, we will use the Church. Please remember that social distancing is required at all of our functions on the grounds outdoors and inside of the Church and building. We must work cooperatively in order to stop this COVID-19.

I am always praying for the good of our Church. I ask that you pray to the Holy Spirit to enlighten our endeavors here at the parish. We are blessed with such a faith-filled community. Keep it up and never lose hope.

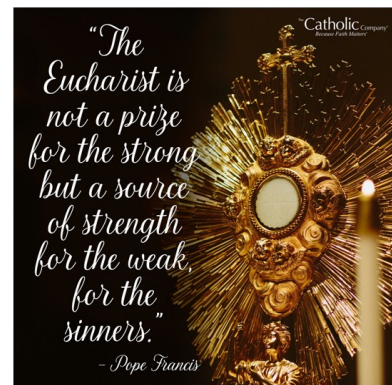
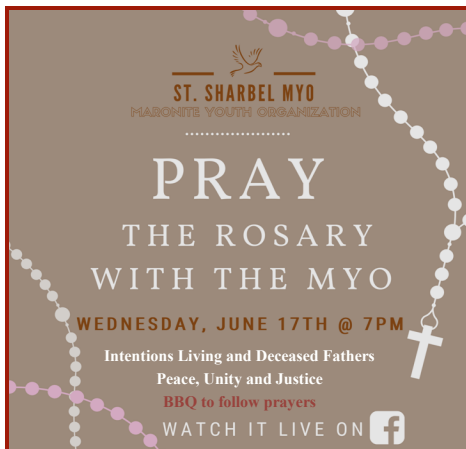
