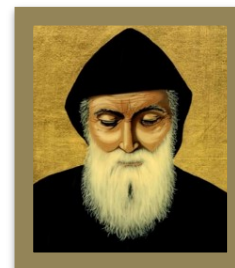

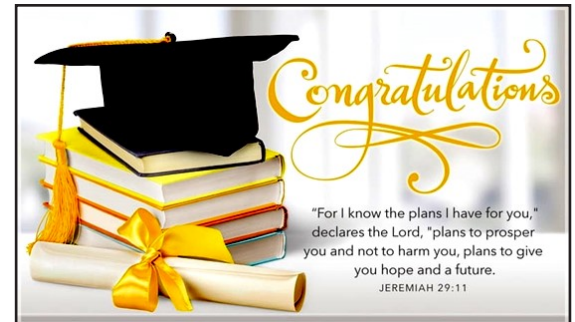
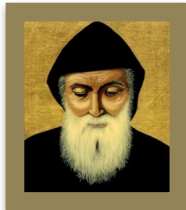

## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Risen Lord:

A word from Pope Francis ~ "Your response to Jesus cannot be conditioned by momentary calculations and convenience. It must be a life-long 'yes'."

Last Sunday's celebration of the Feast of Pentecost was a wonderful, spirit-filled celebration. And it brought our 50-day celebration of the Easter season to a great conclusion. Now that we have completed the Easter season of our church year, we have a few additional weekend feasts of the Lord before we return to the Sundays of Pentecost season. Today we celebrate the first of those feasts -- the Feast of the Holy Trinity.

The first mention of a feast of the Trinity appeared in 1030 and was celebrated on the Sunday after Pentecost. Pope John XXII made it a feast of the universal church in 1334, and chose the first Sunday after Pentecost for the celebration of the new feast.

## CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY - JUNE 23RD

This year, the Feast of Corpus Christi, the celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ, falls on Sunday, June 23rd. After the 4:00 PM, 9:30 AM and 11:30 AM Masses there will be a procession inside the Church to the Chapel where the Blessed Sacrament will be venerated.

One of the most profound ways our union is strengthened and nourished is through the reception of the Holy Eucharist. And one of the most profound ways to prepare for receiving the Body and Blood of Jesus into our being is through frequent and prayerful time spent before the Blessed Sacrament in adoration and veneration.
