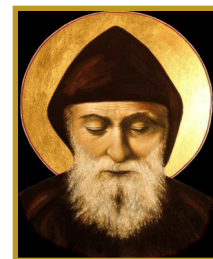

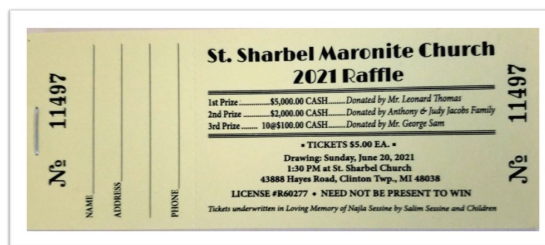

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

IT'S GO GREAT TO BE BACK HOME!!

Happy Father's Day!

This weekend gives us cause for celebration: Sunday is the Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, and Father's Day. Let us ask the Lord to continue to shower down His blessings upon our parish and upon each and every one of its members. Again, know of my prayers for you always, and please continue to pray for me and one another.

Who knew it would take a whole year? Who knew at the start of the COVID pandemic that it would not be until now that we would be entering into Phase 5 of the COVID-19 Protocols. It was exactly one year ago that we had received the initial protocols to allow for in person prayer in our churches. It was just a year ago that we were gathering and training our Check-in volunteers, our Usher volunteers and our Safety volunteers for their respective jobs in our re-opening process.

Now we have been given the green light to move to Phase 5 protocols. Full capacity of our church is now allowed. Fully vaccinated individuals can participate at Mass without face masks and social distancing. Individuals who have not been vaccinated should continue to wear face masks.

We hope to restore altar servers with the Fall Ministry schedule. It is recommended that hand sanitizer be available, required for entering the church and at the reception of Holy Communion. Since holy water fonts have been identified as a potential source of bacterial and viral infection, we will continue to refrain from using holy water for the time being. Because of the potential transfer of saliva, we will continue to refrain from offering the chalice at Communion for the time being. Singing is now allowed! The Presentation of Gifts is restored. The Sign of Peace will continue to be made without physical contact. Offer a friendly wave or nod to your neighbor. We will be working to gradually resume parish meetings and gatherings at pre-pandemic levels.

We have been through an unimaginable past 15 months of pandemic. WE are here today due to God's protection, the safety practices we have been able to put in place and your cooperation in following the safety practices. The development of a COVID vaccine has been an additional blessing as we have taken major steps towards herd immunity. If you have not been vaccinated yet – please – please seriously consider taking this important step we have come a long way in the past 15 months. Help us take the next steps. If you have been attending Sunday Mass through our live streamed Masses and feel comfortable, please consider joining with us in person. The live stream Mass may have filled in a void, but nothing beats being here in person. If you feel like your "soul is hungry," it is! Nothing can replace the gift of the Eucharist in our lives. We are now fully open for in person prayer. Come and be nourished

Thanks to all our volunteers; without YOU our public worship would not be possible!
