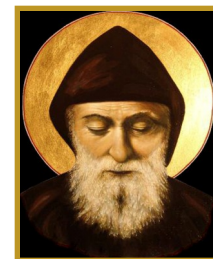

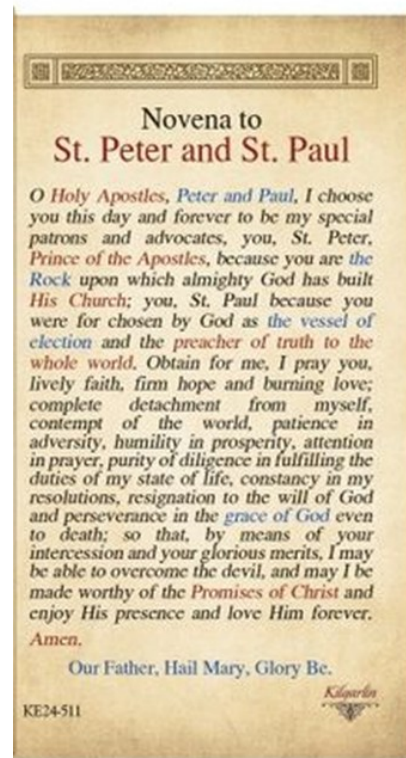

LITURGICALLY SPEAKING

FEAST OF THE APOSTLES PETER AND PAUL

SAINT PETER: Head of the Apostles, was from the town of Bethsaida on the shores of the Lake of Tiberias in the region of Galilee. His name Peter in the Aramaic language is called "Simon" son of John and the Lord gave him the name Peter which means rock. His brother was Andrew and they worked as fishermen at Capernaum.



Peter was married but nothing is known about his family life. Peter and Andrew were disciples of John the Baptizer and called by Christ as His followers. Peter's personality was known to be somewhat hot-headed at times with a fiery temperament. He had a great love of Jesus and followed Him with all his heart. Jesus handed the Church to Peter at Caesarea Philippi and confirmed Peter's primacy after the Resurrection. Peter had authority over the Church given to him by Jesus to preach and teach in Antioch, Corinth and Rome. Peter wrote two epistles that Mark preserves much of his teachings.

He was imprisoned and suffered by crucifixion upside down on June 29, 67 A.D. He did not feel worthy to be hung dying on the Cross as Jesus did. Today there is a Church in honor by the Emperor Constantine where he lies in his tomb.

SAINT PAUL: was born around the year 7 B.C. in Tarsus in Cilicia. He was circumcised on the eighth day and came from the Hebrew tribe of Benjamin. In his youth, Paul learned the trade of making tents. His native province of Cilicia was well known for producing and exporting a goat-hair cloth for making tents. He was a Pharisee and a zealot, but he persecuted the Church.



The things that he considered gain, he now saw as a loss in the light of Christ. In Jerusalem he studied theology under Rabbi Gemaiel and was well-acquainted in both the Greek and Hebrews cultures. Most of the first half of his life he persecuted Christians and was there when Stephen was stoned to death. Paul was known to be the best Jew and the best Pharisee of his generation. He urged the punishment of Jews who accepted Jesus as the Messiah. Disobedient members of the synagogues who were not following the Jewish law were punished by some form of flogging that Paul himself suffered at least five times.

On the road to Damascus, Our Lord appeared to him and he was blinded. He was baptized and began to preach the Gospel to the Gentiles. His travels extended to the Mediterranean and as far as Spain. Paul was arrested and brought before the Jewish and Roman authorities where he was convicted and beheaded.

Paul is known to be the Apostle to the nations where Peter is known to be the chief of Apostles.

May God be Glorified in His Saints!

May their prayers be with us. Amen

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It doesn't seem possible that today is the final Sunday of June. The month is passing way too quickly. Before we begin the month of July, we have a major feast on our Church calendar this week. Tuesday, June 29th is the feast of Sts. Peter & Paul.

Peter was one of the original twelve apostles and along with James and John, was with Jesus at each of the most significant moments in His ministry. St. Paul, originally a Pharisee known as Saul, was called by the Lord to be the apostle to the Gentiles. Originally an adamant persecutor of the Church, Paul led the early missionary efforts of the Church beyond the borders of Israel into Asia, Europe and ultimately Rome. These two apostles are among the "giants" of the early Church.

We look to the saints as role models and examples of encouragement in our own efforts to be disciples of the Lord. We look to them as examples of Christian living as we follow the same path as the disciples of the Lord.

NEXT PHASE

Looking back at the period of strict Covid safety protocol, I remember the multitude of emails that came from the Chancery Office of our Eparchy and the Chancery Office of the Archdiocese of Detroit and the meetings that we had with the Parish Advisory Board, the Finance Committee and the Health Team Committee trying to put together our plans for reopening the parish to the full sacramental life of the Church. Listening to each other we were able to see things that we had not even thought of before. As many of us went home each night, we found our minds racing as we reviewed each detail and anticipated all that could go wrong. Our planning paid off – for the time being – and our parish was open to the extent that the COVID restrictions allowed us to be open.

Last Sunday we experienced our first Phase 5 reopening Masses. The spirit of joy at the Saturday 4:00 PM Mass and the Sunday 9:30 AM and 11:30 AM Masses that I celebrated was awesome. We were able to offer 100% occupancy seating in our Church. Since face masks were not required for those fully vaccinated, we could see each other's smiles. It was a weekend of special rejoicing not only in Church, but also at the numerous gatherings we were now able to attend.

SECOND COLLECTION THIS WEEKEND

This weekend we have the opportunity to participate in the annual "Peter's Pence" Appeal. This collection helps to fund the Holy Father's personal efforts at caring for the needy and suffering of our world. In response to this appeal, we will tithe 5% of this weekend's collection to the Peter's Pence collection.
