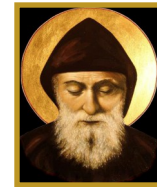

Dear Friends, Family, and Parishioners,

It is wonderfully reassuring to think that during this time of pandemic, we have checked on so many individuals by calling them and asking if they're okay. That shows how not even a quarantine-causing disease can put a strain on our friendships with one another. We never gave up, even when we couldn't be with each other physically. These very thoughts inspired me while I was writing an essay about what true friendship really means. Here it is below:

Friendship is a one of a kind bond. It is not the relationship shared between a husband and wife, nor is it the relationship between parents and their children. Friendship is what unites people together, not through matrimonial love or parental love, but through love of each other's unique personality.

In the greatest friendships, the two friends are like brother and sister, siblings that will never be torn apart, no matter how large of a feud they get into. They learn to accept each other's faults and instead appreciate their good qualities, because that is what brought them together in the first place. They will always be there for each other. After family, that friend is the most trustworthy person they know.

Although, fights can happen. A slight disagreement turns into vicious bickering that results into the most brutal "silent treatment" one has ever seen. But, these are not ordinary friends, they share a significant understanding of each other's innermost feelings.

I promise that when they argue, it brings the friends even closer and strengthens the friendship. Brothers and sisters fight. They're still brother and sister. In the end, no one forgets that. That is the most authentic friendship there is.

Life changed when COVID-19 arrived. But, if we use that change correctly, it can help us become better people. I have developed so many learning experiences during quarantine, especially about true friendships. True friendships carry authenticity, which makes them irreplaceable and long-lasting.
