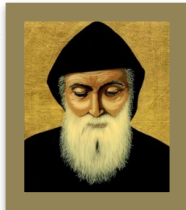

**LITURGICALLY SPEAKING****FEAST OF TWELVE APOSTLES**

These apostles followed Christ as He traveled and were eye witnesses to His numerous wonders. After the Ascension of Jesus back to heaven they continued His work of redeeming mankind from sin. In fact at the Ascension, Jesus commanded the apostles to go out and make disciples of all nations through baptism and to teach nations all that they had observed and all that He commanded of them. He enabled them to succeed in that He bestowed the Holy Spirit upon them (at Pentecost) as they traveled to far away lands.

The authority of the Apostles in the Church was unquestionable from the very beginning. Their powers were derived from Christ Himself. They preached boldly and acted as His representatives, teaching and speaking "in the Holy Spirit." They each have their own separate date of commemoration and they have a joint commemoration on June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Let us rejoice in the ministry of these 12 great men that began the spread of Christianity to the far corners of the earth. Let us remember their sacrifice by our own sacrifice and discipline during the preparatory days ahead in which we are called upon to focus on their commitment and devotion to the Lord's commandments.

**FEAST OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL**

The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul been celebrated by the Catholic Church since at least the 3rd Century A.D.

As Peter and Paul are generally regarded as the two main Apostles responsible for the spread of Christianity in the early years of the First Century, their being honored on the same day is, in effect, a short-hand way of remembering the whole of the Christian faith.

The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul is held annually on June 29th, though some festivities begin late on the evening of the 28th. Tradition says that both Peter and Paul were executed and buried in Rome, Peter in A.D. 64 and Paul in A.D. 67. Peter was crucified upside down, while Paul was beheaded since crucifixion could not be administered to Roman citizens.

His election is an honor for the Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon of Los Angeles.

His episcopal ordination will take place on Wednesday, July 31, 2019 at the Maronite Patriarchate in Bkerki, Lebanon.
