

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Happy Corpus Christi!

On this first weekend of summer, we celebrate the feast of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Now that we have completed the Lent/Easter cycle of our church year, we celebrate a few additional Solemnities of the Lord before we return to the steady cycle of Sundays in the cycle of Pentecost Season. Last Sunday we celebrated the Feast of the Holy Trinity. Now we celebrate the second of our two special feasts – "The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ" (traditionally known as "Corpus Christi").

The Eucharist is the heart of the Christian community. At the Mass, the faithful come together to receive Jesus Christ, the Bread of Life. In the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John, thousands of disciples walked away from Jesus out of disbelief when Jesus told them that He Himself is the bread of life that has come down from heaven and that His flesh is true food and His blood is true drink. Christ fulfilled that teaching at the Last Supper: the night before He offered His Body and Blood on the altar of the cross, He instituted the sacrament of His Body and Blood on the altar of the Mass. The greatest act of mercy and love (the crucifixion) has been perpetually captured in the Mass. Every time we approach the altar at Mass, we approach Christ; we are renewed in our union with Christ; we receive Jesus Himself. Our food for the journey of life, which can be a long journey, is no ordinary bread, but it is Jesus Himself—the real presence of Jesus' body, blood, soul and divinity. Let us stay close to Christ, who is present in the most Blessed Sacrament of the altar. Let us receive Him with devotion, humility, and love. He loves you, and He gives Himself to you in this most precious and sacred sacrament.

Let us renew our love for our Lord in the Holy Eucharist and give thanks to Christ, who is present in the consecrated host at Mass, for the gift of the Holy Eucharist, the sacrament of His love and salvation.

Join us for an indoor procession with the Eucharist immediately following the 4:00 PM Mass this Saturday and this Sunday at 9:30 and 11:30 AM.
