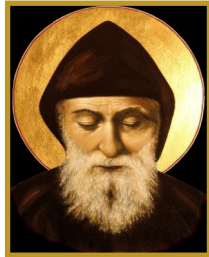

2020 EPARCHIAL CHARITY APPEAL

The corona virus pandemic has disrupted our normal life and caused many casualties at personal, and economic levels. Our church was not spared the effect of this virus on our Parishioners life and well-being. Like all Catholic Dioceses and Archdioceses and other Christian Denominations, our Lady of Lebanon Eparchy still needs to support its mission and provide the financial help to the needy and struggling parishes and missions through the country. The Bishops Appeal Fundraising, which is mostly used for this purpose, was severely affected financially by the effect this pandemic had on all of us. However, we still have the obligation to support this year's appeal which is budgeted for \$12,000 for our parish.

As of May 15, 2020, we have received a total of \$2,100 to support the appeal. I want to thank the parishioners who generously donated and I fully understand the lack of support during these difficult financial times. I want to let you know, to fulfill the appeal's budget, the balance amount of \$9,900 will be paid from the church account. Thank you for your ongoing support and dedication for your spiritual home.
