PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

A word from Pope Francis: "This season [of Lent] urgently calls us to conversion. Christians are asked to return to God with all their hearts, to refuse to settle for mediocrity and to grow in friendship with the Lord."

As we begin the season of Lent, we remember that its purpose is to prepare us for Easter. On Easter, we celebrate the great Feast when Christ conquered sin and death by rising from the dead. United with Christ in our sufferings, life, and death, we will be united with Him in His resurrection.

The three disciplines of Lent are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. I encourage you to do one of each during Lent. Fasting, when we give up some sort of food, reminds us that we are never completely satisfied by everything that we want. Sometimes, we create a lot of unnecessary noise in our lives that distract us from paying attention to God and those around us. Giving something up breaks the routine and reminds us to love God and neighbor. Don't forget that Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat for anyone who is 14 years old and older. Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstaining from meat for people between the ages of 18 and 60.

The Fridays of Lent are of particular importance since every Friday reminds us of Good Friday, when Jesus suffered and died on the cross for us. Prayer turns our attention to the love God has for us, and it also helps us to grow in love of others when we pray for them. Almsgiving refers to works of charity. When we love others, we love Christ.

May this Lent be a blessed time to grow in love of God and neighbor as we prepare to celebrate the most loving act the world has ever seen: the sacrifice of God's only begotten Son on behalf of us for the world's salvation.

Let us continue to pray for one another during this sacred season.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The Stations of the Cross, also known as The Way of the Cross, are a traditional Lenten devotion. The Stations of the Cross serve as an excellent way to tell the Good Friday story. Each station is a place to stop and think about what Jesus is going through at that particular time of His Passion. There are fourteen stations highlighting Jesus' walk to the Cross.



CONFESSIONS Confessions will be available every Friday during Lent at 6 PM before Mass or by appointment



LENTEN REGULATIONS

- Abstinence from meat & meat products is observed on Ash Monday and all Fridays of Great Lent.
- Abstinence is binding on everyone over the age of 14 years.
- Fasting from food and drink (except water and medicine) is observed from midnight until noon on Ash Monday and Good Friday.
- Fasting is binding on everyone between the ages of 18 60 years.
- Those unable to fast due to ill health must perform other penances & works of charity, like attending daily Mass, Stations of the Cross, abstain from watching television, etc.
