





#### PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate the Sunday of the Hemorrhaging Woman, I want to encourage you to make good use of this sacred time so that you may be renewed in faith, hope, and love. There are many things to do to assist you in your Lenten journey: fasting and abstaining from meat, giving something up, charitable works/good deeds, Stations of the Cross, go to Confession, pray the Rosary, attend the Bible Study, pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, daily prayer and Scripture readings, attend daily Mass, and much more.

As we reflect on the forty days Christ spent in the desert, and as we reflect on the action of having received ashes on our foreheads on Ash Monday, we remember that we are created by God and made for union with God. Nothing in creation fulfills and sustains us as much as God. The source of life is God, who is love.

It is easy for us to be distracted in life by many things, most of which are good. However, during Lent we are called to break our routines and take a step back, refocus, and reconnect with God, loving God and others anew. How do we do this? Through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Fasting, giving something up, no matter how small it may be, breaks our daily routine and reminds us that we do not need everything we want. It creates space and reminds us that what we need is to love God and others, which are practiced through prayer and almsgiving. I would like to encourage you to make three Lenten promises, observing each of the Lenten disciplines: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

May the remaining days of this season of Lent be a time to reconnect with God and others and live in the joy and the love of the Lord!

Please don't forget to join us for our parish Lenten Retreat this Saturday, March 12th, which will be presented by Deacon John and Bobbi Sfire. Please see the flier on page four of the bulletin.

I can assure you of my prayers, especially during my Lenten devotions. Let us continue to remember one another in prayer for all of our intentions.
