



PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

On this third Sunday of March, we celebrate the fifth Sunday of Lent with the Sunday of the Healing of the Blind Man and we shift gears in our Lenten journey. Throughout the past week, the daily Scripture readings have been our guide.

During Lent, we often hear about repentance, forgiveness, mercy, love and hope. In fact, the Sunday readings in our Maronite Liturgical Calendar during Lent highlight various stories of physical and spiritual healings.

A sure way to achieve spiritual healing and full health is through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, which is a fitting way to prepare us for the great feast of Easter, the Resurrection of our Lord, the cornerstone of our faith. In today's world, people often believe and act in a relative perspective: "I do everything right." Sin has lost its meaning. Consequently, there is no need to repent and reconcile, but in the Gospel Jesus points and explains it differently: "Let anyone among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her" (John 8:7). Christ taught us a great lesson on forgiveness: "Forgive them for they do not know what they are doing" (Luke 23:34).
