





POPE TO CONSECRATE RUSSIA AND UKRAINE TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

Pope Francis will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on Friday, March 25, 2022 during the Celebration of Penance that he will preside over at 5 PM in Saint Peter's Basilica.

The same act, on the same day, will be carried out in Fatima by His Eminence Cardinal Krajewski, Apostolic Almoner, who is being sent there by the Holy Father.

March 25, 2022 - the day of the Feast of the Annunciation of the Lord - was chosen by Pope Francis for this consecration.

OUR LADY OF FATIMA

As many Catholics know, the message of Fatima was one of penance and prayer. Our Blessed Mother warned of the need to repent or another worse war would come about. She showed a vision of hell and spoke about the sins of impurity which have damned countless souls.

In the apparition of July 13, 1917, in Fatima, Our Lady had asked for the consecration of Russia to Her Immaculate Heart, stating that if this request were not granted, Russia would spread "its errors throughout the world, promoting wars and persecution of the Church." "The good," she added, "will be martyred; the Holy Father will have much to suffer, various nations will be destroyed." The "errors of Russia" have spread – Soviet and Chinese Communism, western Marxism, the plague of abortion, etc.

The intentions of Our Lady of Fatima are clear: true repentance for our sins to turn away the wrath of God

against nations and peoples.

I invite each one of us to join our Holy Father on the Feast of the Annunciation to pray for peace, and entrust these urgent intentions to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
