



PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we mark the Sunday of the Paralyzed Man, and we shift gears a bit in our Lenten journey. Throughout the past week, the daily Scripture readings have been our guide.

On Monday, we were given the path to that glory: stop judging, stop condemning, forgive.

Tuesday: do not perform works in order to be noticed. Wednesday: if we take this path seriously, expect opposition and persecution.

Thursday: trust that God will help us in our efforts to change. Friday: if we ignore the invitation, the invitation will be given to others who will respond.

And Saturday: while we can't respond on our own, God's overwhelming gift of forgiveness can overcome our failures.

Once we realize that we cannot make the changes in our lives that we would like to make on our own, we are reminded that God is on our side and working with us. God never stops pursuing a loving relationship wit Him and takes many steps to help us come back to Him.

This fifth week of Lent invites us to look back at what God initially did for us in the past and to look ahead to Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

Many opportunities for the traditional Lenten practices of Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving are listed in this week bulletin. It also contains our parish calendar of the Holy Week and Easter Masses, devotions, times for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

As we continue throughout this season of Lent the Eparchial Annual Bishop Appeal, we may respond with a donation by using the envelope that was included in the packet mailed to our homes, by marking any envelope with "EBA" or by making an electronic contribution through our website. Thank you for your generous response to this annual appeal.

As Lent progresses, let us continue to pray for and support each other in our Lenten practices.
