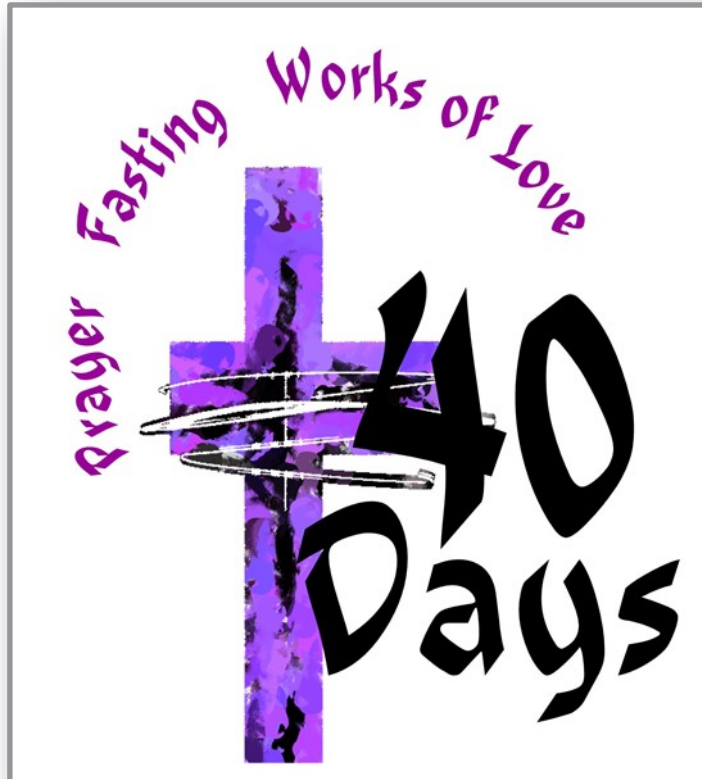

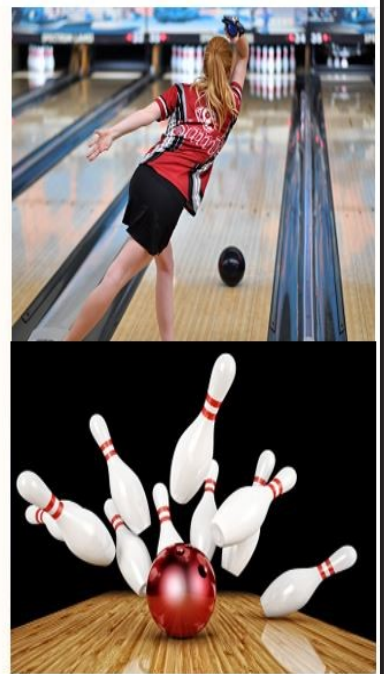

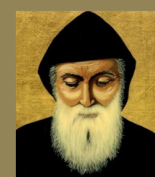

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Dear St. Sharbel Parishioners,

As we promised, I will be updating you on a quarterly basis, and more often if needed, on the status of our loan and our future plan for growth and expansion.

Our current loan balance is \$1,868,709.29 and our monthly payment is \$12,349.71. I want to thank all parishioners who are fulfilling their pledges to support our Capital Campaign. I also want to thank the extended members of St. Sharbel family for their generosity and support of our Capital Campaign.

Our plan is to expand the Capital Campaign to generate additional revenue from special events throughout the year. We will be sharing with you the schedule of these events. Our future growth and expansion will be building the Chorbishop's residency and rectory/church offices adjacent to it. Our current church offices will be used for additional class rooms, and potential storage rooms that are badly needed. We already met with the architect and engineering planning is underway. The plan will be presented to the city for approval. Once the city approves it, we will select a builder and inform you of the timeline.

Let me reiterate what Chorbishop Alfred has said more often. The residency and rectory offices will be funded by a completely separate fund. No money from our church Capital Campaign will be used for this project.

I have said it before, I am so proud to be a member of this family and I want to thank you all for allowing me to serve this family and be part of the growth in Faith and Faithful and expansion. You heard this saying before. "It takes a village to raise a child" and I say it takes pure, supportive, loving and generous hearts and minds to build, expand and maintain our beautiful humble spiritual home. Together we can do it. Thank you and God Bless you and your families.

PASTOR'S CORNER

PRAYER, FASTING, ALMSGIVING, REJOICING!

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Ready or not, this Monday is Ash Monday, the beginning of the Great season of Lent. With Easter celebrated on April 21st this year, it is time to begin the season of Lent this Monday.

Masses and distribution of Ashes on Monday will be celebrated at 9:00 AM, 12:00 PM and 7:00 PM.

Ashes are normally distributed following the homily at all Masses. We hear God's Word calling us to repent and change our lives and respond by approaching for ashes. Please note the Lenten regulations.

1. **Abstinence** from meat and meat products is observed on Ash Monday and all Fridays of Great Lent. Abstinence is binding on everyone over the age of 14 years old.

Fasting from food and drink (except water and medicine) is observed from midnight until noon on Ash Monday and Good Friday. Fasting is binding on everyone between the ages of 18 and 60 years. Those unable to fast due to ill health must perform other penances & works of charity, like attending daily Mass, etc.

2. On the Fridays of Great Lent, the daily Mass will be celebrated at 6:30 PM, followed by the Stations and Benediction of the Cross.

3. The Annual Bishop's Appeal takes place during Lent. Details will follow in a separate mailing.

Lent is the forty day season of preparation for the Paschal Triduum (Holy Thursday evening through Easter Sunday). It is difficult to understand Lent without understanding the Triduum. At its heart, the Triduum celebrates the dying and rising of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We first shared in the Lord's dying and rising when we were baptized. Our former selves died and we were given new life as God's adopted sons and daughters. And since we don't fully live our lives as God's children without the blemish of sin, we need the season of Lent to renew that life within us. So Lent is ultimately a forty-day preparation for the Easter Sunday. It is a steady season of growth, a marathon, not a sprint! Lenten practices are meant to be done and is our annual opportunity to fine-tune our lives as God's beloved children.

FIRST RECONCILIATION

All First Communion candidates are required to make their First Reconciliation this Sunday, March 3, 2019 from 10:30—11:20 AM. We look forward to celebrating your First Holy Communion with you in May!
