





PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I hope that Lent is going well for you. Today we mark the fifth Sunday of Lent with the Sunday of the Paralyzed Man. This week -end we welcome amongst us Deacon John and Bobbi Sfire and we are very grateful for taking the time to be with us. May God grant them the health and the joy!

OUR HOLIEST WEEK (PART I)

The liturgical services on Palm Sunday and the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Sunday) are among the very best things we do in the Church. Everyone is encouraged to come and participate in these extraordinary celebrations.

"Entrance" – this seems to be the key to understanding the liturgy of Palm Sunday. On this day the Church celebrates Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem to accomplish His Paschal Mystery. We go with Christ into Jerusalem. This is one of our most joyful and triumphant processions of the entire year. When we gather, we receive a palm and we sing "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!"

The Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. The Gospel proclaimed reminds us of Jesus washing the feet of His disciples. There is an experiential component to this since twelve members of the parish have their feet washed by the celebrant. Adoring the Lord in the Holy Eucharist is certainly highlighted here. We understand that our love for Jesus must be displayed in loving acts of service toward one another. Hence, we have the washing of the feet.

Following the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Eucharist which will be shared on Good Friday is taken in procession to the tabernacle and the church is then prepared for Good Friday. Adoration continues until 10 PM. The altar is stripped and the cross is covered.

Please continue to pray for one another, and know of my continued prayers for you and your loved ones during this most sacred season of Lent.




