



LITURGICALLY SPEAKING



The three disciplines of Lent are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. I encourage you to do one of each during Lent.

In my Pastor's Corner, I mentioned two important events that will help us grow in prayer this Lent. I can't encourage you enough to take advantage of these opportunities that are certain to bless you.

Fasting, when we give something up, reminds us that we are never completely satisfied by everything that we want. Sometimes, we create a lot of unnecessary noise in our lives that distract us from paying attention to God and those around us. Giving something up breaks the routine and reminds us to love God and neighbor.

Don't forget that Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat for anyone who is 14 years old and older. Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstaining from meat for people between the ages of 18 and 60. Fasting allows for one modest meal with two smaller meals that, if combined, would not equal the larger meal. Of course, exceptions can be made for health. Friday is of particular importance since every Friday reminds us of Good Friday, when Jesus suffered and died on the cross for us. Prayer turns our attention to love and be loved by God, and it also helps us to grow in love of others when we pray for them.

Almsgiving refers to works of charity. When we love others, we love Christ. May this Lent be a blessed time to grow in love of God and neighbor as we prepare to celebrate the most loving act the world has ever seen: the sacrifice of God on behalf of us for the world's salvation.

to our brothers and sisters in need.


May we walk in your ways
