





# WEAR RED NEXT SATURDAY & SUNDAY

Next Sunday, May 23rd, we will celebrate the feast of Pentecost. Pentecost is the festival when Christians celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit to the Church. It is celebrated on the Sunday 50 days after Easter (the name comes from the Greek pentekoste, "fiftieth").

Pentecost is regarded as the birthday of the Christian church, and the start of the church's mission to the world.



On Saturday, May 22nd and Sunday, May 23rd we encourage everyone to wear red to Church. The color red symbolizes joy and the fire of the Holy Spirit, recalling the fiery tongues that descended upon the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary when they received the Holy Spirit in the Upper Room.

# FROM OUR POPE

Pope Francis has dedicated the month of May to a Rosary "prayer marathon" that began on May 1st. It will stretch around the globe during this Marian month of May.

The intention for the daily Rosary, to be led by a different Shrine each day, is the end of the pandemic. Specific intentions related to the pandemic will also be included. The Rosary will be broadcast each evening at 6 pm Rome time (12 EST) by the Vatican.

On May 1st, Pope Francis kicked off this special month in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, praying with his eyes turned to the "Madonna of Succour" (Our Lady of Help), a famous representation of the Virgin venerated from the 7th century, found in the Gregorian chapel, above the altar of Saint Leo. The Pope has placed himself under her protection.

Rosaries blessed by Pope Francis have been sent to the 30 Shrines that will take turn leading the Rosary. Throughout the month of May, the thirty Shrines will conduct the Rosary in their language and according to their own tradition, explains the Pontifical Council for Evangelization.

On Saturday, May 29th, Our Lady of Lebanon (Lebanon) will lead the Rosary.

#### FROM OUR POPE

Pope Francis has asked the Holy See to coordinate Sanctuaries throughout the world to host a Rosary to be prayed throughout the month of May. On Saturday, May 29, 2021 the Shrine of Our Lady of Lebanon in Harissa will be hosting this Rosary. More information will be provided on how to join in this special prayer.

May Our Lady continue to be for us the Help of Christians and the Cause of our Joy.

### A REMINDER—YEAR OF SAINT JOSEPH

On December 8, 2020, Pope Francis declared a "Year of Saint Joseph", so that we may reflect on the spiritual value of the Saint who is called "Patron of the Universal Church".

Our first Maronite parish in the United States, established in New York in 1890, came under the name of Saint Joseph. We have parishes named after Saint Joseph in part of our Eparchy. Some of our parishes also have Saint Joseph Societies. Saint Joseph always has a place in every Maronite heart.

Saint Joseph, the "foster father" of Jesus and the "chaste spouse" of the Virgin, also has two feasts to his honor in the Maronite Church: the Fifth Sunday of the Season of the Glorious Birth, just before Christmas, as well as March 19th. These feasts bring attention to different aspects of Joseph's role as the "Virgin who cared for the Virgin", and the Patron of the Universal Church.

What a grace for us to honor Saint Joseph. The Holy Father has granted plenary indulgences for those who honor the Saint during this special year dedicated to him. A visit to any one of our parishes named for Saint Joseph, as well as those parishes hosting a Saint Joseph Sodality, would be included in this indulgence.

There are so many treasures hidden in the person of Saint Joseph; we can only begin to explore. Who else could have loved and cared for the Virgin Mary and the Christ Child with such tender and masculine love, such obedience to the Heavenly Father, and such fidelity to his noble mission?

O Saint Joseph, foster father, faithful spouse, guide to the troubled, and true patron of believers, pray for us!

We are planning a special Divine Liturgy followed by a procession on Monday, May 31st at 7:00 PM. We encourage all parishioners and friends of the parish to join us for this devotion.
