



PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Friends and Visitors,

A word from Pope Francis ~ "The Church is or should go back to being a community of God's people, and priests, pastors and bishops, who have the care of souls, are at the service of the people of God."

During these middle Sundays in May, we continue our celebration of the Lord's Resurrection with the Sixth Sunday of Easter. We move into the final part of the Easter season and turn our attention upon Jesus' parting gift of the Holy Spirit.

HAPPY SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF OUR LORD! HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION

This coming **Thursday**, **May 26**, **2022**, we celebrate our Lord's Ascension into heaven, which we profess every Sunday during the Creed. On the fortieth day after Easter, Jesus ascended into Heaven. Then, during the nine days that followed, the Apostles prepared to receive the Holy Spirit. This was the first novena (traditional nine days of prayer). On the fiftieth day after Easter, after seven weeks had passed (a week of weeks), the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles, uniting us to Christ and giving the Church the grace and power to continue the work of Christ so that the whole world may be one in Him.

On Thursday, let us keep our eyes fixed on the Heavenly Lord as He sends us out to live out and proclaim the faith. We are reminded in one of the prefaces of the Ascension that Jesus "ascended, not to distance himself from our lowly state but that we, His members, might be confident of flowing where He, our Head and Founder has gone before." We remember that the Holy Spirit unites us to Jesus and has been given to us through the Church. With faith, hope, and charity, we are called to follow our Lord to heaven, and this calling impacts the way we approach our daily lives. Let us strive to live in friendship with our Lord, and as we prepare to celebrate Pentecost, I'd like to encourage all of us to pray "Come, Holy Spirit" throughout this week, inviting the Holy Spirit into our lives, friendships, workplaces, parish, and homes: Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and kindle in us the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and we shall be created, and You shall renew the face of the earth. O God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that we by the same Holy Spirit may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations. Forever and ever. Amen!
