





LITURGICALLY SPEAKING

THE FEAST OF PENTECOST is of great importance as it marks the coming of the Holy Spirit. Today on the front of the bulletin we have an icon from the Rabulla Gospels. The Gospels were with the Maronites since the 6th Century. They are one of the oldest surviving biblical manuscripts and are based on the Syriac Peshita version of the Gospel.

The icon invites us to contemplate the scene of the Gospel and live it in your own life. The large blue arch in the icon symbolizes the heavenly realm. The trees that are growing above the blue represent the Garden of Paradise. The Holy Spirit descends on the Upper Chamber where the apostles are assembled at Pentecost. "Blessed is He who exalted Adam and caused him to return to Paradise." (from Hymns on Paradise from St. Ephrem). The dove descending is the Spirit of the Living God. It descends from the blue heavenly realm and enters the earthly realm to rest on Mary who is speaking with the apostles. The dove echoes Jesus' earlier baptism. This is also reflective of the scene in Acts 2:3 where tongues of fire come to rest on each disciples head.

The inclusion of Mary in the icon is important. Syriac theology has been instrumental in the development of early Marian theology. The icon puts Mary center stage in the scene and puts her in a place of prominence. Her dark blue robe stands in contrast to the paler blue of the apostles and her halo is golden in comparison to the violet of the apostles. The icon is depicting the gathering of Christ's Church. Christ had ascended nine days earlier and left Mary as the leading Church custodian among the apostles.

Around Mary you can see a concentration of red which is representative of the divine. This is a typological reference to God who in the Old Testament is fire (for example the burning bush at Mt Sinai). The rocky sapphire stones on which they stand are a reference to Exodus 24:10 "and they saw the God of Israel. There was under his feet as it were a pavement of sapphire stone, like the very heaven for clearness." They now see God by way of the Spirit.

Take a moment this Sunday and contemplate the icon. Feel the warmth of the Spirit in your life. The Holy Spirit is the link for us between heaven and earth.

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

As we celebrate the feast of Pentecost this weekend, it is important that we pray for an outpouring of all of these gifts of the Spirit upon ourselves, our parish and our larger church.

As in the past, SAFETY is our number 1 guideline. If you haven't been vaccinated, please take whatever steps you need to help us move beyond this pandemic.

As we continue to make progress against the COVID-19 virus in Southeast Michigan, the following liturgical restrictions are being amended by the pastor effective June 13, 2021.

Changes in our parish practice won't happen overnight. We will be thinking through the adjustments we can make in the next few weeks.

- Reinstate the procession with the bread and the wine, including members of the faithful bringing the gifts to the altar.
- It is no longer imperative for the parish to enforce social distancing during the Communion procession. Since it is such a short period of time, social distancing is not crucial here.
- Holy water fonts may be filled and used.
- The sign of peace may be reinstated within households: with the words, "Respecting our needs to distance, let us offer each other a sign of peace."
- We are cleared to a 60% occupancy of our Church for in person prayer.

Some things will remain, like face masks, hand sanitation as we arrive into the lobby of the church and before receiving Holy Communion.

Welcome home to our college students who are gradually making their way home following their spring semester exams. Many took their exams this past week. Know that you were remembered in prayer here at your parish. It is good to have you back home. Congratulations to those who have graduated over the past few weeks. This is a great time in your life. Celebrate it well!
