

Dear Parishioners and Friends, A word from Pope Francis ~

On the feast of the Most Holy Trinity, we are to go back to our roots. This Sunday we are celebrating the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity and we are to go back to the divine revelation of God. He has poured love into our hearts and it is overflowing. This love is so abundant that it is to impact our lives each and every day. So all-encompassing is this love that even death cannot destroy it, but only perfect it. The union of the Father and the Son and Holy Spirit is profound. The love between the Trinity is so pure and so unifying that it overflows. Blessed are we who receive it and share it with others.

MEMORIAL DAY

Tomorrow, Monday, May 31st, is Memorial Day. Mass will be celebrated at 9:30 AM in the Chapel. Let us remember in a special way our fallen soldiers.

CORPUS CHRISTI

One of the most significant ways we experience union with God during our daily lives is receiving the Eucharist at Mass. Next Sunday we will be celebrating the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi, venerating the presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. We will provide flower petals for the girls to strew before Jesus, who is present in the Holy Eucharist and carried in procession. We will process inside the Church.

SAFETY FIRST

As in the past, SAFETY is our number 1 guideline. Even if you have been vaccinated, we all need to continue to be mindful of one another's well being and be concerned with the safety of everyone. Let us be charitable to each other as we move through this next phase.

As we continue to make progress against the COVID-19 virus in Southeast Michigan, the following liturgical restrictions are being amended by the pastor effective June 13, 2021.

Some things will remain, like face masks, hand sanitation as we arrive into the lobby of the church and before receiving Holy Communion.

- Reinstate the procession with the bread and the wine, including members of the faithful bringing the gifts to the altar
- It is no longer imperative for the parish to enforce social distancing during the Communion procession. Since it is such a short period of time, social distancing is not crucial here.
- Holy water fonts may be filled and used.
- The sign of peace may be reinstated within households: with the words, "Respecting our needs to distance, let us offer each other a sign of peace."
- We are cleared to a 60% occupancy of our Church for in person prayer.
