

*Car payment and car insurance graciously paid for by Deacon John and Bobbi Sfire and family.

*Our goal for the Eparchial Charity Appeal, which is collected during the season of Lent, is \$14,000.00. We have never reached our goal, usually collecting about half. The remainder of the amount is deducted from our Church savings.

The weekly collection amount needed is \$6,500.00 to meet our monthly operational expenses.


