

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I pray that all of you had a wonderful week since I last wrote to you and/or saw you at Church for our Liturgy. One thing that is of great concern for me is the fact that many of our elderly are not receiving the Eucharist. To the best of my understanding health officials really do not want us to gather and socialize with those who are compromised. I hope this will not last much longer.

I am offering to come and visit the elderly and give them Holy Communion. I propose to do this by just coming to your doors. If you do not wish to have me visit please feel free and let me know. I will only give you the Body of Christ. Unfortunately I will not be able to stay and talk even if only for five minutes.

If you are concerned please let me know and I will not come. I would like to do this on Saturday, October 17 and 24. I will come with the Eucharist between 10:30 AM and 1:00 PM allowing me to get back to church and prepare for the 4:00 PM Divine Liturgy.

My plan is to begin in Macomb county on the 17th and then do the outskirts on the 24th. If anyone would like to set up a different day and time please feel free to call me at [630] 440-2452 and we will-decide what works best for all.

Another concern is the fact that many have not been able to go to confession. I will plan an evening for confession in the month of November in order to prepare ourselves for the Announcement (Advent) and the Glorious Birth of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

I will hear confessions at church but will be available to visit the shut-ins and those compromised at their homes by hearing their confessions at their doors. I think it is most important that we keep a regular schedule, as best as possible, for the Sacraments of the Church.
