



This weekend we celebrate the 7th and the last Sunday of the Season of the Holy Cross. Remember to turn your clocks back for next Sunday. Daylight Savings Time ends on 4/5 November!

THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

Christ the King Sunday, the last Sunday in October (and Reformation Sunday) on the Extraordinary Form Calendar and on the and the final Sunday of the Liturgical year on the Ordinary Form calendar, is a feast day that focuses on the authority of Christ. While the problems our world faces today differ from the particular events that inspired Pope Pius XI to establish this feast in the 1920s, his message and call to honor Christ the King in a society that denies the authority of Our Lord is no less pertinent now than it was then.

As tensions mount in the Middle East, let us pray for the safety of civilians on all sides. Too many innocent Palestinian, Jewish and Christian people have died in needless violence. Let us each invoke the Prince of Peace to bring stability and calm to the region.

HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION ALL SAINTS DAY

Wednesday, November 1, 2023, Feast of All Saints, is a Holy Day of Obligation. The Divine Liturgy will be celebrated at 9:30 AM and 7:00 PM. A Holy Day of Obligation means that a Catholic person is obligated to attend Mass on that day. Please join us as we commemorate the saints and the righteous and just.

ALL SOULS DAY

Celebrate with us on Thursday, November 2, 2023 All Souls Day with Masses offered at 9:30 AM and 7:00 PM. Although not a holy day of obligation, it is a very special time when we remember our beloved dead and pray for all the souls in purgatory.
