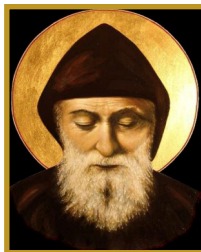

VOTING AS A CATHOLIC

“...our Catholic faith *must* impact how we vote. Voting is a moral act. It is a value-based decision about the best person or the best course of action for our community, our state, or country. Voting is an exercise of our consciences and therefore it has a serious moral impact. It is imperative for a disciple of Jesus to take this responsibility seriously because our elections have profound consequences.

Rarely does the Church tell us precisely how we should vote in a specific instance. Because it is an act of the conscience, we have the responsibility to be properly informed about the candidates and issues. But we also need to be properly formed by the Gospel. Part of this formation is understanding what the most important issues are. To this end, we have come to understand the preeminence of the protection of the right to life for the unborn in our society. I’ve written before why this issue has priority over other issues.

Because of this issue’s importance, the Bishops of Michigan, led by Archbishop Vigneron, are encouraging and inviting all Catholics and all men and women of goodwill to reject Proposal 3 in this election. There is a wealth of information about the more effective ways we can support women and children in our state rather than altering our constitution to allow unrestricted abortion until the time of birth.”

On this final Sunday in October, we celebrate the 7th Sunday and the last Sunday of the Season of the Holy Cross and the Feast of Christ the King.
